

Surgical Implants

At Southern Oregon Periodontics we want to provide you with the highest quality & most affordable implants possible. We work very closely with your dentist to make the whole process streamlined and stress-free.

The first thing you will notice about a dental implant is how closely it resembles your natural tooth in both feel and function. It is surgically inserted into the jaw which allows the bone to fuse around it. The implant is made of titanium which will not decay and will **last a lifetime** if cleaned and maintained properly.



If there is sufficient available bone, extraction and **immediate implant placement** may be completed at same visit.

There are some cases that may require an additional surgical procedure, such as extraction & socket preservation, ridge augmentation or sinus lift, before implant placement is possible. Healing time could take 2-4 months before the site would be ready for the implant.

The best way to find out if you're a candidate for surgical implant placement is to schedule a free consult with Dr. Chou. We would be happy to discuss your options and further explain the implant process!

Typical Course of Treatment

Once the implant is placed it will need to integrate with the jaw. We have specifically chosen Straumann implants due to their biological compatibility. In some cases they can be **ready-to-restore in only 2 months!**

When it is ready we will uncover the implant and attach a healing abutment. After 2 weeks you may return to your general dentist to have impressions for the final abutment & crown.
